Additional Fees & Information

\$50.00 Non-Refundable Registration Fee.

One week advance tuition deposit is due at the time of enrollment (\$135, \$175, or \$195). The advance deposit reserves your child's space for the weeks specified. We are unable to allow transferring contracted weeks. This deposit is applicable to the last week of attendance provided all fees have been paid.

Field Trips: Field trip fees are included in tuition. Half-day schedules may not be possible on days when a full day field trip is scheduled. On such days, attendance would require a \$10.00 tuition charge to extend schedule to 3:00.

10% Discount available on tuition of second child enrolled full-time from the same family in either the Elementary program or the Pre-school program.

Payments not received within 3 days of payment due date will be charged a **\$25.00 late fee. \$50.00 returned check fee.**

Children bring lunch from home. Milk is provided with lunch. Morning and afternoon snacks are provided. Nutritious lunches required.
